

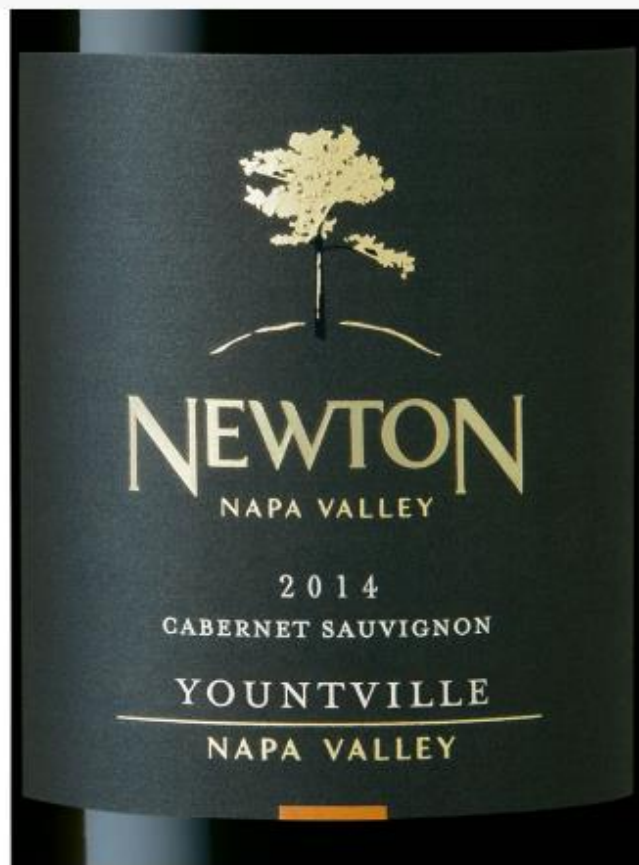

## 9 Big California Red Wines for Dads

These bold California Cabernet Sauvignons are made for celebrating Father's Day.

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### NEWTON 2014 YOUNTVILLE CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Founded in 1977 by Peter Newton and Dr. Su Hua (and now owned by LVMH), in 2012 this winery decided to focus solely on Cabernet Sauvignon. To mark the winery's 40th anniversary, [Newton Vineyard's](#) winemaker Robb Mann selected three 100 percent estate grown Napa Cabernets: Spring Mountain, Mt. Veeder, and Yountville. As excellent and distinctive as all three single vineyard Newton anniversary wines are, it is the 2014 Yountville Cabernet Sauvignon (\$190) that we picked as having the most individuality. Barrel aged for 12 months in 50 percent new French oak, this wine is full of rich blueberries with undercurrents of licorice and black olives. It should be decanted at least an hour before serving to tame its youthfulness, but it also holds the potential for long-term aging of up to 20 years.
